Manteo - Roanoke Island

Just a short ride from Hatteras Island is Roanoke Island and the town of Manteo which is the capital and hub of Dare County. Unlike other county seats, you will find Manteo to be a beautiful and charming blend of city planning combined with many landmarks which highlight and featuring its historic roots. This town is well worth seeing and experiencing by any Outer Banks visitors.



One major attraction is the **Lost Colony** outdoor drama playing nightly at the Waterside Theatre. It tells the story about the long standing mystery of the first colony established on Roanoke Island and how it had disappeared when English ships returned years later. You will also learn about Virginia Dare, the first American born person of English decent.



Elizabeth II is a sixty-nine foot, square-rigged sailing ship built as the centerpiece of America's 400th Anniversary Celebration to represent one of the vessels used to transport Sir Walter Raleigh's colonists to the New World between 1584 and 1587. The ship is located across from the Manteo waterfront at Roanoke Island Festival Park.

The Elizabethan Gardens is located adjacent to The Lost Colony's Waterside Theatre and Fort Raleigh National Historic Park on Roanoke Island. The gardens are open year-round, seven days a week. These beautiful Gardens offer historic reflections set among fantastic collections of seasonal foliage. The staff is extremely helpful in advising how to add some of the plants and flowers to your own home gardens.



Don't forget to check out the North Carolina Aquarium on Roanoke Island! We invite you to come and visit the 68.000-square foot facility located on the Outer Banks. The Aquarium features many exciting and unusual residents that will guide you through your exploration of the "Waters of the Outer Banks."

The Aquarium has something for everyone, and features sharks, alligators, and river otters as well as programming that includes dive shows, live animal encounters and feeding



programs. The Aquarium has several special activities to choose from and unforgettable events. Be sure to include a visit to the Aguarium for a fun, exciting, and educational experience!

Ocracoke Island




The quaint little island of Ocracoke is no more then a short free ferry ride away. Ocracoke Island is actually in our neighboring Hyde County and has only one town which is the Village of Ocracoke. It is also a part of the Cape Hatteras National Seashore managed by the National Park Service. There is a NPS visitor center at the south end of the island near the south ferry dock. Ocracoke Village has municipal docks in the town's center where private boats, charter boats and coastal traveling boats harbor. Ocracoke was the stomping ground and ambush point for

Blackbeard and his pirates. It was also just off Ocracoke's that Blackbeard's pirating career came to a violent end.

After the ferry trip from Hatteras, a short distance down Hwy 12 your first stop should be a look at the "Banker" ponies. The Ocracoke Pony Pen is manned by the NPS and has several ponies that are said to be direct descendants of ponies left on Ocracoke Island from Spanish shipwrecks during sixteenth century exploration.

In the late 1950s, Ocracoke Boy Scouts cared for the horses and had the only mounted troop in the nation. By law, the free-roaming animals were permanently penned in 1959 to prevent over-grazing and to safeguard them from traffic after the highway was built in 1957. The remaining herd has been cared for by the National Park Service since the early 1960s. Currently, there are seventeen horses in the Ocracoke herd. While in Ocracoke Village stop at the NPS visitor center and learn all about Blackbeard and the Island's fascinating history. The NPS also conducts a very interesting guided walking tour through the village.



Hatteras Island Coast Guard



Hatteras Island is extremely proud to have one of the finest Coast Guard stations in the world. This Sector Field Office (SFO) at Cape Hatteras provides logistical support to all Coast Guard assets on the Outer Banks of North Carolina and to the Small-boat Station and Marine Safety Team (MST) located at Elizabeth City. They are a fully mobile support unit capable of providing a myriad of services to all operational units in the northern AOR.
