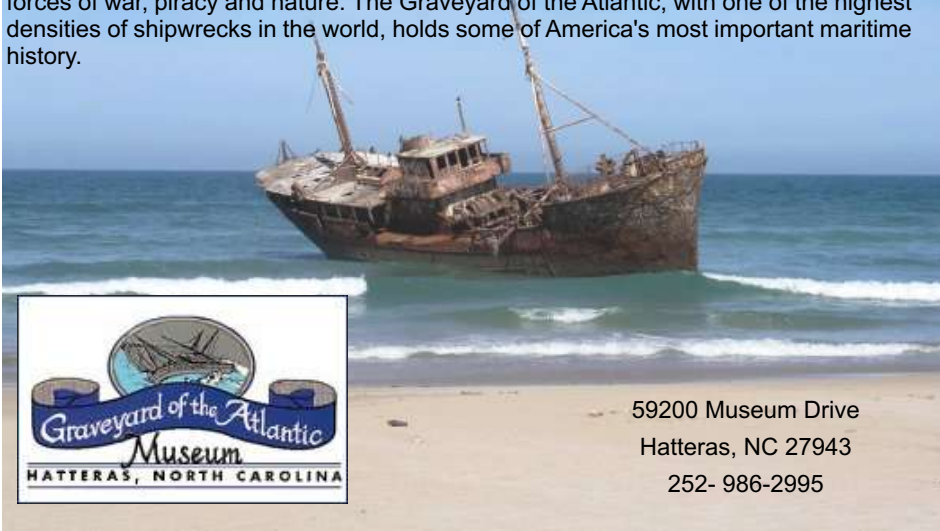


Graveyard of the Atlantic Museum

Native American Museum

NCDOT Ferry System



The North Carolina Dept. Of Transportation runs one of the finest and most dependable ferry systems in the nation. Many Hatteras Island visitors will either arrive by ferry or use the ferry system to explore other parts of Eastern NC while they are here.

The ferry routes that affect us locally are:
Hatteras Island to Ocracoke Island 40 min. (free)
Ocracoke Island to Swan Quarter 2.5 hrs. (fee)
Ocracoke Island to Cedar Island 2.5 hrs. (fee)

The Hatteras to Ocracoke ferry is free both directions. The other routes are based on total vehicle length.

National Park Service

Hatteras Island is referred to as the Cape Hatteras National Seashore and is under the control of the National Park Service. The NPS has a visitor center located at the Cape Hatteras Lighthouse in Buxton. All Park Service rules and regulations apply to the island from Rodanthe south. The north end of the island is called Pea Island because it was once a separate island. This area is under the US Fish & Wildlife.

The NPS sponsors many activities daily. You can stop by the visitor center or go to NPS.gov to get a complete schedule. All park visitor centers are open year-round, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., mid-June through Labor Day and 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. the rest of the year.

The activities may include;

- * Climbing the lighthouse
- * Lectures on various topics pertaining to the lighthouse and the Outer Banks
- * Bird walks
- * Nature trail walks
- * Fish with a ranger program for the youngsters



Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge

If you are entering the island from the north over Oregon Inlet you are bound to see a series of ponds on the right that is normally filled with all manner of unique birds. From the south end of the Bonner Bridge to the north end of the Village of Rodanthe is the Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge and is under the US Fish & Wildlife. The refuge has a visitor center located approximately 5 miles south of the bridge.



The refuge's stated objectives are;

- * Provide nesting, resting, and wintering habitat for migratory birds, including the greater snow geese and other migratory waterfowl, shorebirds, wading birds, raptors, and neotropical migrants.
- * Provide habitat and protection for endangered and threatened species.
- * Provide opportunities for public enjoyment of wildlife and wildlands resources. Public use programs focus on interpretation, environmental education, wildlife observation, wildlife photography, and fishing.
